Handover of keys in Langenlonsheim

SCHULZ Farben- und Lackfabrik GmbH celebrates the handover of the keys to the new „Janhanna“ logistics center after a 12-month construction phase

Now it is unmistakable: An idea became reality. In a festive setting, representatives of SCHULZ Farben, the general contractor GOLDBECK, as well as the banks and the municipality of Langenlonsheim-Stromberg met on the morning of September 01, 2022 to celebrate the handover of the keys to the new logistics center.

At the ceremonial handover of the keys, CEO Michael Schulz looked back at the beginnings of the project: „On July 05, 2021, we met here for the groundbreaking ceremony and I said at the time that we would meet again at this very location in 15 months at the latest - now we can already celebrate the handover of the keys today after just 14 months and a construction period of only 12 months.“

It can thus be said that the major project was successfully realized and what is even more gratifying is the fact that both the time schedule and the budget plan were adhered to.

The handover of the keys completes what began with the initial planning in 2019. The largest investment in the history of SCHULZ Farben- und Lackfabrik GmbH was made, making the company even more efficient and future-proof. The focus is on customer satisfaction, which was clearly underpinned as the most important asset with the completion of the project.

All warehouse capacities were centralized at the new address „An der Altnah 4“. The logistics center „Janhanna“, named after Michael Schulz’s children, offers 21,000 pallet spaces with a size of 12,600 square meters. The investments in the production area also increase efficiency and boost the productivity of SCHULZ. Consequently, the expansion ensures that the company can respond precisely and quickly to the respective order volume. The foundation for a positive future of the company has thus been laid, and at the same time SCHULZ, as one of the most important employers in the region, is securing its location and jobs in the long term.

SCHULZ Farben- und Lackfabrik GmbH, based in Langenlonsheim, Germany, was founded by Dieter Schulz in 1966. With approximately 340 employees and sales of more than €95 million in 2021, the company is one of the most important medium-sized paint manufacturers in Europe. As a private label supplier to well-known DIY and home improvement stores and as a contract filler for retail chains, SCHULZ produces emulsion paints, varnishes, glazes, plasters and creative products for Germany and abroad.
